To be eligible for consideration, entries must be postmarked **NO LATER THAN May 17, 2010**. Letters of acceptance or rejection will be mailed by June 1, 2010. Please reply promptly.

REGISTRATION RULES

The Concours Committee reserves the right to reject any automobile which does not meet minimum standards of our Concours. Class sizes will be limited to the 10 best judged entries and 12 total entries. The Committee also reserves the right to change a car's classification or to change or combine classes depending on the number and type of entries.

"FOR SALE" or other commercial signs, displays, and illustrations are prohibited in the Concours area. Special Cars For Sale area will be available for a fee. No trailers will be allowed on the Concours field. Special parking and unloading areas for trailers will be provided. No Tents or Pop-ups will be allowed on the Concours field.

JUDGING AND SCORING

Cars will be judged on interior, exterior, engine and chassis based on authenticity, general appearance, care and preparation. Any entrant may elect to have his or her car **JUDGED** or entered for **EXHIBIT ONLY**. The car being **JUDGED HAS FIELD PRIORITY**. In either case, if accepted for the main field, the car will be placed within the appropriate class. **EXHIBIT ONLY** cars may be placed in the Special Exhibit Area. **EXHIBIT ONLY** cars **MAY NOT** be changed to be judged on the day of the show. **ALL JUDGED CLASSES** will be judged by the SCCA, except for some marque classes and special awards. Last year's first place winners are for **EXHIBIT ONLY**.

CAR ENTRY FEE

This \$50 car entry fee includes admission for two adults, gift, program and two continental breakfasts. Checks will be returned if entry not accepted. There will be no refunds for cars withdrawn after acceptance.
